#### **3. Description of the training offered:**

The Tech Fundamentals program is meant to prepare individuals for entry-level careers in cybersecurity and IT. The program lasts a total of 23 weeks, including 16 weeks of classroom training and a 7 week paid internship or project-based learning experience. Classroom training is four hours per day Monday through Friday, either 9:00am – 1:00pm or 2:00pm – 6:00pm. Cohorts launch in the Spring and Fall.

#### **4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:**

- CompTIA IT Fundamentals+
- CompTIA A+
- Google IT Support
- Google IT Project Management

#### **5. Am I eligible?**

To be eligible for this training program, applicants must:

- Must be young adults 18-26 years old, military veterans, or military spouses
- Must have a GED® or High School Diploma
