Commercial driver's license training is an important component of the Transportation, Distribution and Logistics industry. This training prepares students to test for a Maryland CDL-A license.

Student Qualifications

Each student MUST:

- be at least 21 years of age.
- be able to pass a Department of Transportation (DOT) drug screen & physical.
- possess a valid Maryland Driver's License (regular Class C).
- maintain zero points for drug/alcohol violations.
- must have access to reliable, personal transportation.

The CDL-A training is 10 to 15 weeks.
