NOTICE OF REPROPOSED CHANGES TO REGULATION: MONEY TRANSMITTERS

The Commissioner of Financial Regulation reproposes to amend certain existing Regulations, recodify certain existing Regulations, and adopt new Regulations under **COMAR 09.03.14 Money Transmitters**.

To view the reproposed changes, see the Maryland Register, Volume 50, Issue 18, Page 811 (issued September 8, 2023). Licensees should review these amendments thoroughly.

The Commissioner previously proposed changes to the Money Transmission Regulations that were Published in the Maryland Register, Volume 50, Issue 4, Pages 124 – 125 (issued February 24, 2023). Because substantive changes were made to originally published regulations, the regulations have been reproposed. While most changes clarify the language in the regulations, the changes within COMAR 09.03.14.03 have amended the subject to focus on the **person** rather than the **activity** that does not constitute money transmission and how that is determined.
