
As provided by the Licensed Design Professionals' Overlapping Practice Guide for Local Government Officials issued by the Maryland Design Boards on October 1, 2004, this is a determination made by an overlapping practices panel (the "Panel") in response to your Request for Determination regarding the above project.

The Panel, which included the representatives from the State Board for Professional Engineers, the State Board of Architects, and the State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects, met on December 2, 2004 to review your Request. The Panel also reviewed certain architectural drawings, as well as mechanical, electrical and plumbing drawings that were submitted in connection with such Request.

After the review of the plans and discussion, the Panel unanimously agreed that the mechanical, electrical and plumbing drawings should have been signed and sealed by a Maryland professional engineer. In arriving at this conclusion, the Panel cited the magnitude of the project's design and the complexity of calculations as primary reasons for its decision.
